

# St. Rose of Lima Car Line Map 2018-19



We're committed to the safety of your children and we want to make things easier on you! Beginning this Monday, August 20th, please follow these five simple steps!

1. Carefully review the arrival and dismissal times included in the Parent & Student Handbook or the reverse side of this map.
2. Enter the car line during your regular time with your *SafeDismissal* family card on display.
3. Ride the *car line wave* listening to your favorite music, radio talk show or just enjoy a few extra minutes of peace and quiet before the kids arrive. Please expect a wait.
4. Stay in your vehicle and let us do the rest! All children must exit from the passengers side of the vehicle. Preschool/Kindergarten families and siblings only will use the car line on NE 5th Ave for drop off. During dismissal, only preschool families will use NE 5th Ave.
5. Be patient! The first few days will be slow moving but we'll soon pick up momentum!

Are you new to St. Rose of Lima? If so, these additional details will help you with our arrival and dismissal procedures. Still confused after reading the guidelines below? Don't hesitate to speak with your child's teacher or contact the school office for assistance. It's our pleasure to help!

### **Useful Tips for Morning Drop Off:**

1. Regular drop off is from 7:35am-8am; preschool 3 families may park and walk between 8-8:15am (see details below). Please be aware that the later you arrive, the longer the wait in carline. All students are expected to be seated in their desks by 8am or they are considered tardy. Please arrive in the carline by 7:45am to allow ample time for your child to get a stress-free start to their school day!
2. All families are asked to use the carline, with the exception of our Preschool 3 families. Only parents who have a 3-yr old student may park on the preschool side of campus between 8-8:15am and walk their child to class. Preschool 3 families with multiple children are asked to use the carline before 8am to drop off older siblings then return between 8-8:15am to walk the 3-yr old to class. Please note that if a family with a 3yr old wished to drop all children off in the carline, they may choose to do so between 7:45-8am.
3. Parents may not park around the perimeter of school to walk their child(ren) to the gate between 7:35am-8am. This is a serious safety hazard for our students and creates congestion on our neighborhood streets. Only neighborhood families are permitted to walk their children to school.
4. All families with Preschool and/or Kindergarten children are asked to drop off on the preschool side of campus.
5. Families with children in grades 1– 8 only, must drop off using the carline in the church parking lot. Follow the wave!

### **Useful Tips for Dismissal:**

1. SRL has a staggered dismissal schedule. PreK3– Grade 4 will dismiss at 2:35pm (regular dismissal)/12:35pm (early dismissal). Families in 1<sup>st</sup> dismissal (2:35pm), please be aware that our entrance gate will not open until approx. 2:20pm; do not arrive earlier or you will block local traffic. Families picking up in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dismissal (3pm) are asked to arrive no earlier than 2:50pm to avoid getting caught in our first dismissal carline. Anyone who arrives too early from our 2<sup>nd</sup> dismissal may not be permitted to enter the lot.
2. **Please continue to display your dismissal card (pink or yellow) on the dashboard so we can easily identify your family and swiftly pair your child(ren) when you pull into our pick up lane.**
3. In an effort to further reduce congestion in our lot and maintain safety for our smallest Cardinals, all preschool families and siblings, may pick up on NE 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. This carline is indicated by the blue cars on the map.
4. Although it may seem like you're driving through a maze, please follow the pattern indicated on the map and marked by the cones. We have wrapped our carline in the lot to get as much traffic off our local streets as possible. Please expect to wait in the car line; movement will be intermittent as students are loaded.
5. All parents are asked to remain in their vehicles. As you pull into our pick up area, which is the same lane as morning drop off, the students will be directed to your car. Younger children will be assisted by a teacher or staff member. **Please have your dismissal card with your family name clearly displayed on your dashboard so we can swiftly pair your child.**
6. Traffic will exit onto NE 107<sup>th</sup> Street. If you need to make a left hand turn, please use the left gate; right hand turns, please use the right gate. When traffic is backed up on the road, we may direct you to use one particular exit gate.
7. No texting and driving!
8. Please keep your dogs at home. If Fluffy must come along for the ride, please keep her away from the windows and doors when our staff member is greeting your family.
9. When rain is in the area, the school will call a "rainy day dismissal." All families will be asked to park their cars and pick up their child(ren) from each individual classroom. The school gate will open at 2:45pm or 12:45pm (early dismissal).
10. All students not picked up by the 2nd dismissal carline will be sent to aftercare. Charges may apply. Pre-approved walkers will be released after 2nd dismissal has concluded (approx. 3:15pm regular day/1:15pm early release).
